

## Frequently asked questions

### **How should I use the assessed student work tasks included in this teacher support material?**

The assessed student work tasks included in this teacher support material are intended as examples of good practice. They have been written to address certain MYP language B objectives at the three differing levels. It is expected that teachers will use them as examples of how to create an assessment task, how to address certain objectives, or to look at examples of standards, but there is no obligation for teachers to use these tasks in exactly the way they are presented here.

### **Where can I find other example material like that presented in this teacher support material?**

The MYP language B teacher support material includes assessed student work in six languages: Chinese, English, French, German, Japanese and Spanish. Each language version contains different examples of assessed student work. If you are familiar with more than one of these languages it may be worthwhile to look at the other language versions.

You can also find example material, either officially published by the IBO or submitted by teachers, on the language B home page of the OCC. To access the OCC, you will need a valid e-mail address and password: your MYP coordinator can then set up an account for you.

MYP workshops are an ideal place to obtain examples of schemes of work, units of work and assessment tasks being used in MYP schools, as workshops often include sessions where teachers share their teaching practices. ### **Where can I go if I have a question that is not answered in the *MYP Language B guide* or this teacher support material?**

Your MYP coordinator may be able to answer your question. If not, posting a message on the language B discussion forum on the OCC can often prompt answers from other MYP teachers. Alternatively, your coordinator may pass your query to your regional office or the International Baccalaureate Curriculum and Assessment Centre (IBCA).
